Please note New Club rules regarding non-appearance are: Miss 1 game = warning, miss 2 games = pay ice for both missed games, miss 3 games – removal from competition.

#### DIBCA Rolling Stones

This competition is suitable for younger or newer members. Team Members rotate positions during the game. Played on Mondays at 4.30pm. Entries may be limited.

#### Sweepers Pairs

Teams of two players are drawn to play games in a knockout format. A more experienced member is drawn as skip. Substitutes must be members who **are not** entered in the competition. Played on Thursdays at 4.30pm. The winning two teams will be invited to play in the Muirfield Pairs, a Young Curlers Competition.

#### Junior Sweepers League

Open to all members, teams are formed by Curling Development Officer. Played on Thursdays at 4.30pm. A set number of games are played and then the league splits in to two leagues for the second half of the season.

#### Thomson Roddick Singles Competition

Open to members at any level. Members play individually. The shorter games are played to a variation of normal Curling Rules. Members play in Sections and then split into High and Low Roads for the top two players in each section. The competition is played over two days (usually just before Christmas). Limited to 24 players.
